REGULATIONS

4'th CANTANTES LUBLINENSIS International Choral Music Festival 2019 has the character of a competition and will take place on 22 – 23 November 2019 in Lublin

I Organizer:

✓ The Polish Union of Choirs and Orchestras

II Goals of Festival:

- ✓ Popularization of artistic values of choral music
- Presentation of the achievements of choral music composers associated with the city of Lublin and popularization of their work
- Popularization of Stanislaw Moniuszko works in The Year of Moniuszko on the bicentenary of the composer's birth
- Presentation and confrontation of choirs and bands achievements, exchange of experiences, establishing contacts between ensembles
- ✓ Improving the performance level of amateur choral teams
- ✓ Promotion of Lublin

III Registration conditions:

Festival participants may be amateur choirs and vocal ensembles from
 Poland and abroad, appearing in 9 categories:

A children's choirs

- A1 children's school choirs (to 10 years)
- A2 non-school children's choirs (do 10 years)
- A3 children's school choirs (to 13 years)
- A4 non-school children's choirs (do 13 years)
- A5 children's school choirs (to 16 years)
- A6 non-school children's choirs (do 16 years)
- A7 choirs of music schools of I degree

B youth choirs

- B1 mixed youth choirs
- B2 youth homogeneous choirs
- B3 mixed youth choirs of music schools of II degree (post-primary schools)
- B4 youth choirs of equal voices of music schools of II degree(postprimary schools)
- C homogeneous choirs (over 19 years)
- D academic choirs
 - D1 university choirs
 - D2 choirs of music academies and music faculties
- E mixed choirs of associations, culture centers, singing societies etc.
- F parish choirs
- G seniors choirs (average age above 50 years)
- H vocal ensembles (number of members to 18 persons)

OPEN CATEGORY choirs and vocal ensembles of 12 – 18 members

A 10% deviation from the proposed age and number of participants is permitted.

The basis of participation is correct completion of application available on the www.pzchio.lublin.pl website and sending the scan to the address: pzchio.lublin.pl@gmail.com with the short information (in version "for edition") about choir/ensemble, picture and notes in e-version

The deadline of application sending is **11.10.2019**.

IV Conditions of participation:

- Competition repertoire in categories A H should include maximum four diverse works a cappella (one vocal – instrumental work is allowed) whose total time is 10 – 15 min. along with entering and leaving the stage (prolonged performance may be interrupted by the Jury)
- Competition repertoire in OPEN category should include maximum four diverse works whose total time is 10 – 15 min. along with entering and leaving the stage (prolonged performance may be interrupted by the Jury)

The organizers encourage to include additional scored compositions in the competition repertoire:

a piece or work arrangement of Stanislaw Moniuszko (maximum 2 points regardless of the number of performed Moniuszko's works)

a piece by a Lublin Composer, submitted to the COMPETITION FOR LUBLIN COMPOSERS (maximum 2 points regardless of the number of performed Lublin composers works – a set of notes available on the website <u>www.pzchio.lublin.pl</u>)

The best performances of the above-mentioned works will be awarded with a SPECIAL PRIZE (1500 PLN).

- The Artistic Council makes the qualifications for the Festival and its decisions will be communicated electronically to the choirs: for choirs from Poland to 18.10.2019
 for choirs from abroad 7 days after receiving the application
- ✓ The choirs qualified to participate in the Festival pay an entry fee in the amount of 400 PLN until 18.10.2019 to bank account:

Title of the payment should include:

the participating choir name/CANTANTES LUBLINENSIS 2019

The entry fee will not be returned if a choir qualifies for the Competition and decides to resign

The confirmation of the payment of the entry fee should be sent by e-mail to the following address: pzchio.lublin.pl@gmail.com until **25.10.2019.** Lack of payment may result in deletion from the list of Festival participants

- Choirs can appear in more than one category. For participation in each additional category, an entry fee of 300 PLN must be paid
- ✓ The choirs will bear the costs of transport, accommodation and meals on their own
- Changes to the competition repertoire and the order of performance may be made by 15'th November 2019

✓ Grand Prix winners can re-enter the competition after two years

V Contest criteria:

- Performances of the choirs will be evaluated by an international Jury consisting of at least 4-5 members, appointed by the organizers
- The Jury members will evaluate the performances of the choirs by taking into consideration
- Evaluation criteria: technical: voice emission quality and the choir's vocal culture, intonation and diction and rhythm interpretative : the performance style typical, the choice of a repertoire and the general artistic effect of the competition performance

The announcement of the results of the competition will take place on 23.11.2019 at 07:00 p.m.

- Prize for the 2'nd and 3'rd choir of CANTANTES LUBLINENSIS (1500 PLN)
- ✓ SPECIAL PRIZE (1500 PLN) for the most interesting performance of the piece or arrangement of the piece by Stanislaw Moniuszko
- ✓ SPECIAL PRIZE (1500 PLN) for the best performance of the work of Lublin Composer, submitted for the Competition for Lublin Composers
- $\checkmark\,$ SPICIAL PRIZE for the best conductor of the contest (1000 PLN)

- ✓ Other SPECIAL PRIZES
- ✓ Distinctions (material awards), diplomas of participation

The Jury has the right to distribution of prizes other than provided for the regulations.

The organizer has the right to award non-statutory prizes.
